

FIRE WARDEN COURSE OUTLINE

THEORETICAL SESSION - 2 Hours

- Fire Tetrahedron including the components of a fire (oxygen, fuel, heat and chemical chain reaction)
- Review the legal requirement in relation to Part V (Fire) of the Occupational Safety and Health Act, 2004 amendment 2006
 - ⇒ Means of escape in case of fire
 - ⇒ Safety provisions in case of fire
 - ⇒ Instructions as to the use of means of escape in case of fire
 - ⇒ Provision of adequate firefighting equipment
- Roles and responsibilities of the Fire Warden and Emergency Team
- Fire extinguishers classification (pressurized water, carbon dioxide, multipurpose dry chemical, foam, wet chemical)
- Identification of key components of the fire alarm and suppression systems
- Knowledge on the operations and interpretation of fire alarm and suppression systems
- Evacuation plan execution following the emergency response procedure
- Management systems that incorporates fire drills, routine inspection and maintenance of fire equipment and associated documentation

PRACTICAL SESSION - 2 Hours

This will allow all participants to assess a fire emergency in an occupational setting, select the appropriate fire extinguisher and practice the PTASS technique to extinguish the simulated fire. Participants will have hands on training with fire alarm systems and scenario activities that will trigger the necessary emergency response. The necessary evacuation process will be executed with the main goal to preserve life and prevent property damage.

TARGET AUDIENCE

Individuals in all types of building occupancies that are part of the organization's in-house emergency response team, responsible for evacuating the staff to the various muster areas.

- Minimum amount of persons - 10
- Maximum amount of persons - 15
